Initial situation

Both economic and also political events can lead to an unexpected threat for companies and people. Such situations can endanger the attacked organisation and, in extreme cases, even bring it to a complete standstill for a certain amount of time. The innocent employees in the in-house mailrooms or secretary's offices are very often affected.

Objective

With our x-ray service «SPS X-Ray» we ensure that employees in endangered companies feel safe at all times while at work and that the business processes can also be continued as normal if there is a threat.

- X-ray the incoming daily post (letters and parcels)
- X-ray courier deliveries
- X-ray private post

Our solution

The security check by SPS is done on the basis of a cohesive process operation which we determine individually with each customer. Here our services range from retrieving and x-raying the postal items to passing them on personally to the specified people.

The letters, parcels and courier deliveries are generally x-rayed in the specially secured rooms of SPS. On request we can also do this in a protected room at the customer's location.

During the security check, the incoming post is examined by our certified experts with specialised x-ray machines and double checked for suspicious contents using the two-man rule. With the available

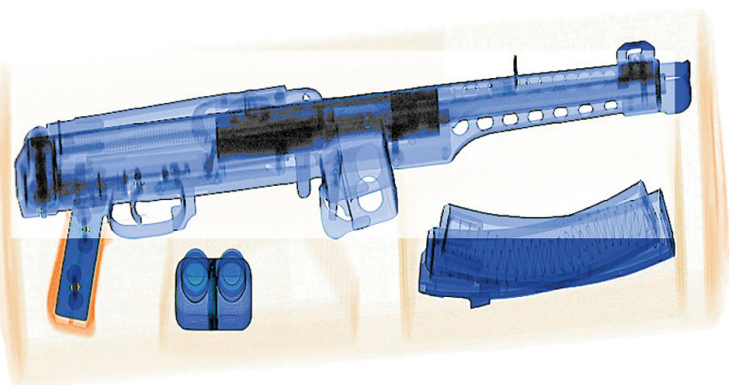


infrastructure we can clearly detect if a delivery contains hidden weapons, letter or parcel bombs or other dangerous items.

After the security check all examined post is labelled accordingly and passed on to the specified people by hand.

Dealing with suspicious post

If an item is identified as suspicious, SPS labels this as «rejected delivery» and determines together with the recipient what shall be done with it. If the recipient also does not know the contents of the delivered item or, for security reasons, does not want it delivered, the police will be contacted for their analysis.



If delivered items contain a potential explosive device, our specialists keep these locked up in a bomb case and alert the emergency services immediately. In the event of intervention, cooperation with authorities and police organisations is well-practised and has proven itself many times in practice.
